How to March


ROYAL ROSARIANS

There are several simple principles to marching effectively in a Rose Festival Parade:

Uniform: Make sure your personal appearance meets the Rosarian Code of Conduct. Correct fit and cleanliness of the uniform are required.

Formation: Make sure that you check your spacing in the Rosarian marching unit and that you doff (tip) your hat at an *exact* 45 degree angle when the drillmaster signals with a whistle.

Parade Behavior: Consult your membership roster for rules on appropriate and dignified behavior in the Rosarian Code of Conduct.



How to Marshal or Escort

While acting as a band marshall or float escort in a Rose Festival Parade is primarily a ceremonial duty, there are some important rules to follow:

Marching Band Unit: Arrive early and introduce yourself to the Band's Director in addition to the key advisors. Let them know you are there to help with Parade Organizers. If a Parade Marshal asks you to assist in moving-up or slowing-down the parade, please abide and do the best you can. In case of an "emergency," find and ask a parade marshal to assist in getting help. Parade Marshals are available along the parade route and wear orange vests.. Know your surroundings. Observe where you are. Be another set of "eyes and ears" for the band director. Trust your instinct, if you see a concern, contact a Parade Marshal. Stay Hydrated.

Float Unit: With Grand Floral Parade floats, the Rosarian Parade Escort is an official escort. Arrive early and introduce yourself to the float's coordinator as well as any participants riding on the float. On occasion, the float will have an additional group of participants marching in front of, or around, the float. *March at the back right corner of the float*. Studio Concepts, the company that designs most of the floats, will have a representative with the float at all times that is positioned at the front left of the float, and assists the float driver through remote instruction for turns and speed.


HINT: Arrive early for dinner and park near the Hotel deLuxe. Then, proceed with other Rosarians to the formation area in the North Park Blocks.

The **Hotel deLuxe** located at 729 Southwest 15th Avenue, Portland, OR 97205 is the informal Starlight Parade Headquarters for Royal Rosarian activities before, during, and after the Starlight Parade.

You are encouraged to make no-host dinner reservations at the hotel's restaurant Gracie's, 503.219.2094, prior to the parade to enjoy time with numerous Rosarians and their quests.

Rosarians who are unable to march and spouses are invited to attend the complimentary **Hosting by Starlight Event** in the hotel's Screening Room (pictured at right) where the entire Starlight Parade may be viewed in high definition. **Space is limited so please use discretion with additional guests.**

AFTER the parade, the Rosarian Marching Unit returns to the hotel for complimentary snacks and no-host beverages at the exclusive Hosting by Starlight party at the Hotel deLuxe.



Jr. Parade Shuttle for Rosarians

Many Rosarians will arrive in the Hollywood District and park on the streets West of NE 33rd Avenue prior to the parade. A shuttle will be available to Rosarians in the QFC lot that will transport Rosarians to NE 56th and Halsey, at Normandale Park where you will meet your assigned band if Marshaling. Rosarians walking as a unit or with their Grandchildren will have to make the short walk from the 56th and Halsey drop off to 52nd and Sandy to assemble to march in the parade. The Shuttle will also be available to return Rosarians that park near the meeting place at Normandale Park following the parade.



AFTER the parade, a courtesy bus greets Rosarians close to the disband area. A Rosarian representative at the end of the parade route will assist you. The bus offers transportation to the DoubleTree Lloyd Center. Royal Water will be available on the bus.

(LEFT) Red arrow indicates where Rosarian checkin will be for the Marching Unit. A truck with information will be parked in the lower level of the Blazer office parking lot west of the Rose Garden. The Yellow Line shows how the parade progresses into the Memorial Coliseum.

(BELOW) The yellow lines indicate how floats are queued up along NE Interstate on each side of the Tri-Met MAX Light Rail. Float marshalls meet their floats along this street.



Park at the DoubleTree Lloyd Center Hotel for free, and take MAX to the **Rose Garden station**. Walking into the Coliseum is easier through its West End.
